

Drive to Walnut Pioneer Village

Head West on 240th St/LeClaire Rd toward 210th Ave/Utica Ridge Rd 266 ft Turn Right at the 1st cross street onto 210th Ave/Utica Ridge Rd 5.0 miles Turn Left onto 290th St/St Anns Rd 2.2 miles Turn Right into the parking lot across from the Pioneer Village 7.3 miles Dan Nagle Walnut Grove Pioneer Village and Olde St. Ann's Church 18817 290th St, Long Grove, IA 52756

Drive back to Davenport West Kimberly U-Haul

Turn Left onto 290th St/St Anns Rd 5.8 miles Turn Left onto 130th Ave 7.5 miles Follow 130th Ave, Wisconsin Ave and W Kimberly Rd to Davenport 4.6 miles Turn Right Destination will be on the Left U-Haul Moving & Storage of West Davenport 3616 W Kimberly Rd, Davenport, IA 52806
