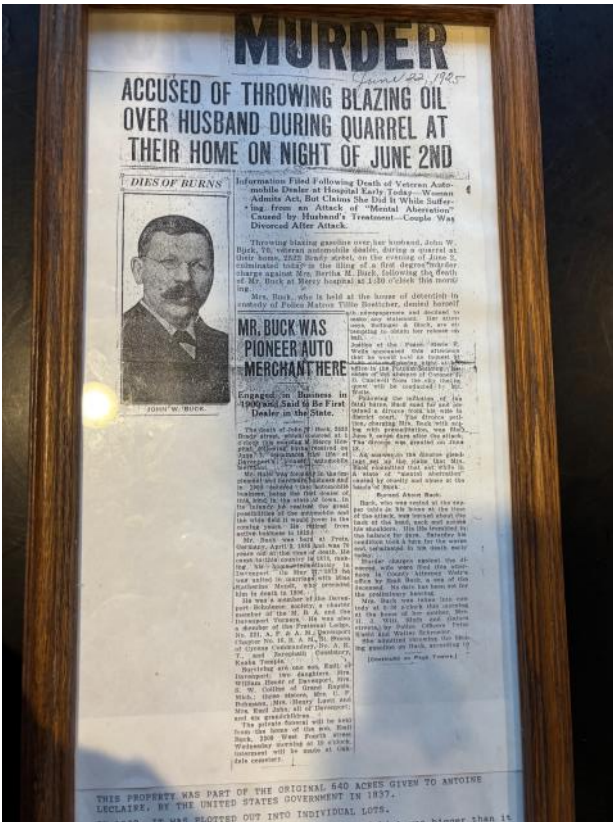

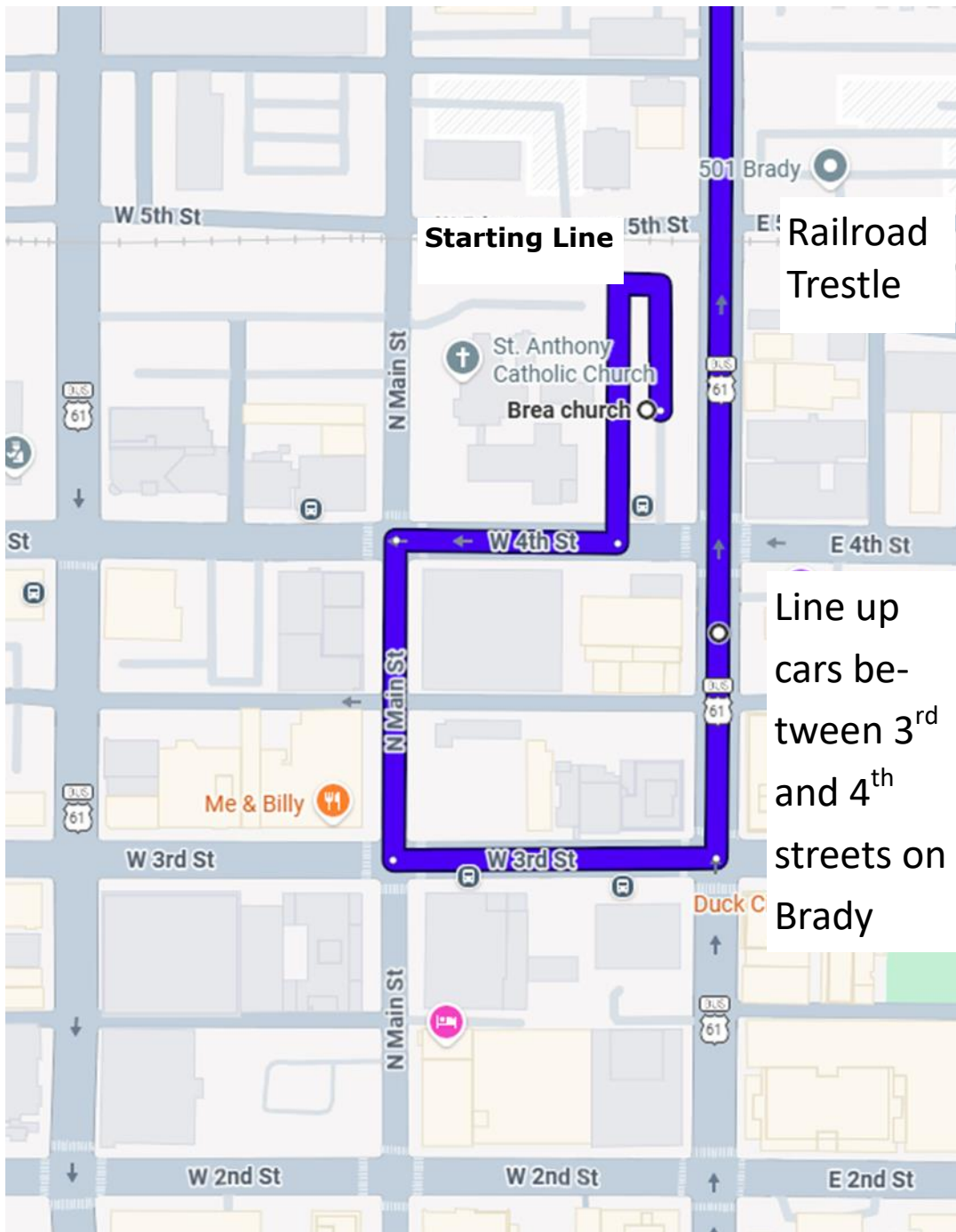

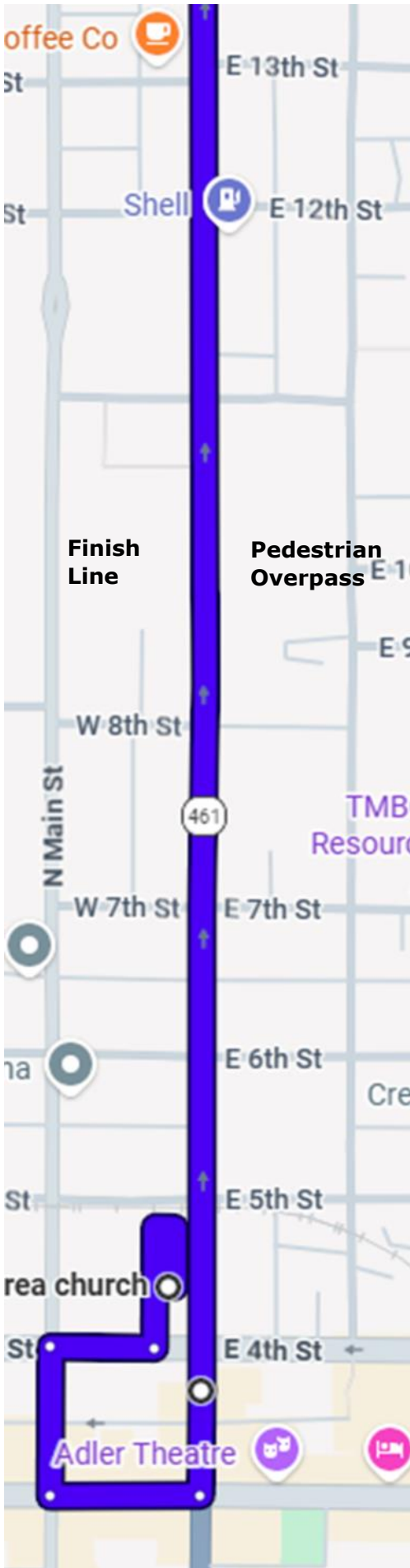
Saturday July 11th 9:00 AM Hill Climb Distillery Tour - The AACA MVR will retrace the route of the first tour sponsored by the Davenport Automobile Club in 1904 between Davenport and LeClaire. Activities will include a self-timed hill climb of Brady Street Hill, tour of the Vanderveer conservatory, picnic in LeClaire and a tour of the Mississippi River Distilling Company. The distillery will charge \$5 for the tour, but will provide discount alcohol purchases. Mike Flaherty will load his Model T engine manifold cooker with hot dogs and buns for the picnic. We will assemble for the tour at the City of Davenport public parking lot next to St Anthony's Church at 4th and Brady at 9 AM for safety inspections and a driver safety meeting. Cheap souvenir digital stopwatches will be provided to the first 24 cars for the self-timed Brady Street hill climb between 5th Street Railroad Tressel and the Palmer Overpass. Please obey the posted speed limit on Brady Street while climbing the hill.

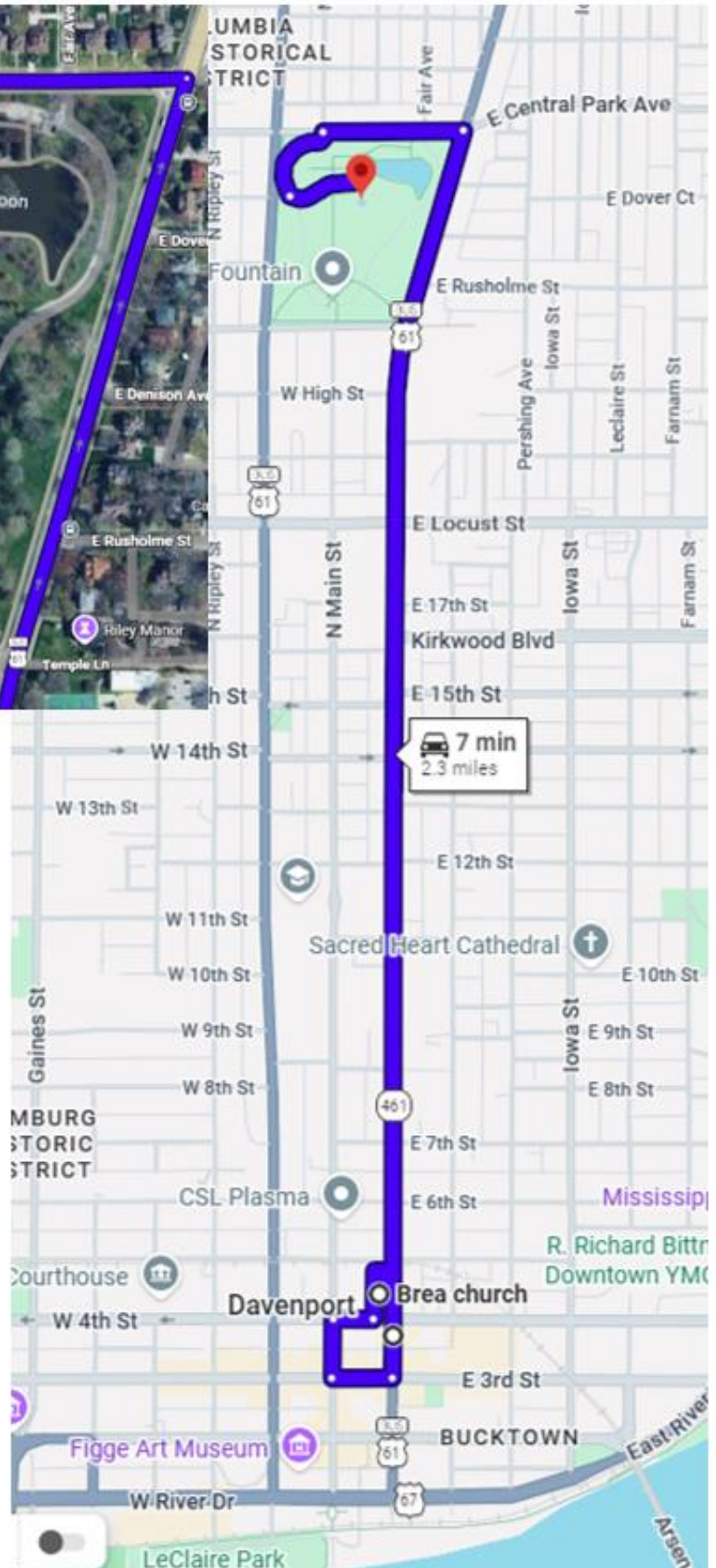
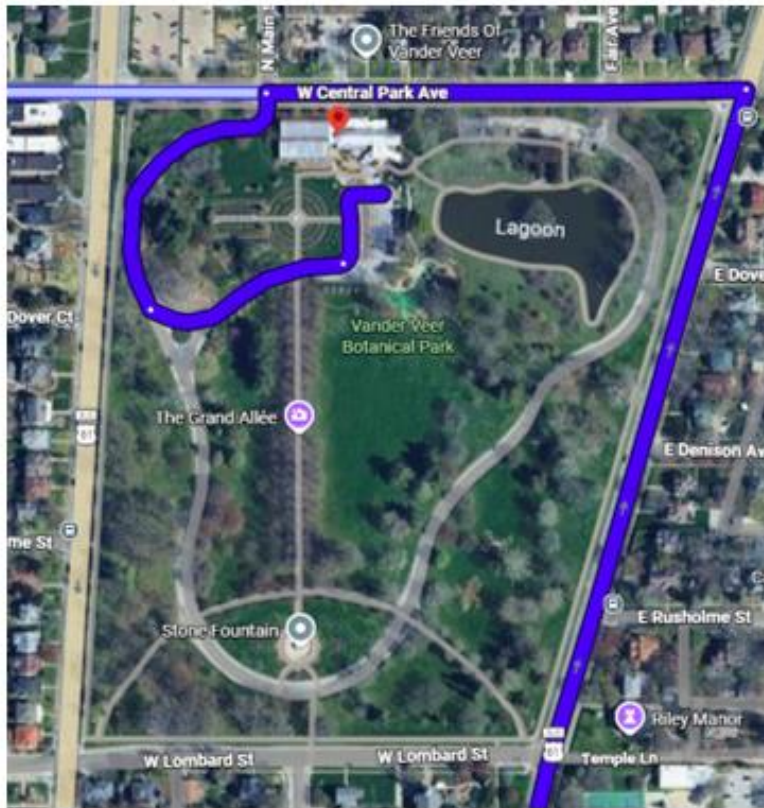
After the hill climb, cars will assemble at the Vanderveer Conservatory for a self-tour of the botanical collection. At 11:00 we will leave as a group to travel to LeClaire via Brady Street and Blackhawk Trail / Territorial Road, picnic at Scout Park, then tour the Mississippi River Distillery before following the River Road to Davenport and finish for ice cream at the Diners Delight. Please RSVP to Mike Flaherty by July 4th, so he can provide a count of individuals to the distillery for the tour, call (314)968-8575 or email flaherty_michael@sbcglobal.net



Assemble in public parking lot at 4th and Brady Street, across from St Anthony's Catholic Church. We will have a short safety meeting at 9:00 AM and then start the tour. Stop watches will be provided to first 24 participants. Drivers need to obey posted speed limit on Brady.

Cars will leave the parking lot, and line up in the far-right lane on 4th and Brady, and get a running start when traffic light turns green. The self timed hill climb will start when drivers pass the entrance under the railroad trestle on 5th and Brady, continue up Brady Street hill and stop their time at the entrance to the pedestrian overpass at the top of the hill, between 8th and Palmer Drive. Drivers will then continue on to the Vander Veer Botanical Park Conservatory and regroup at the parking green house parking lot

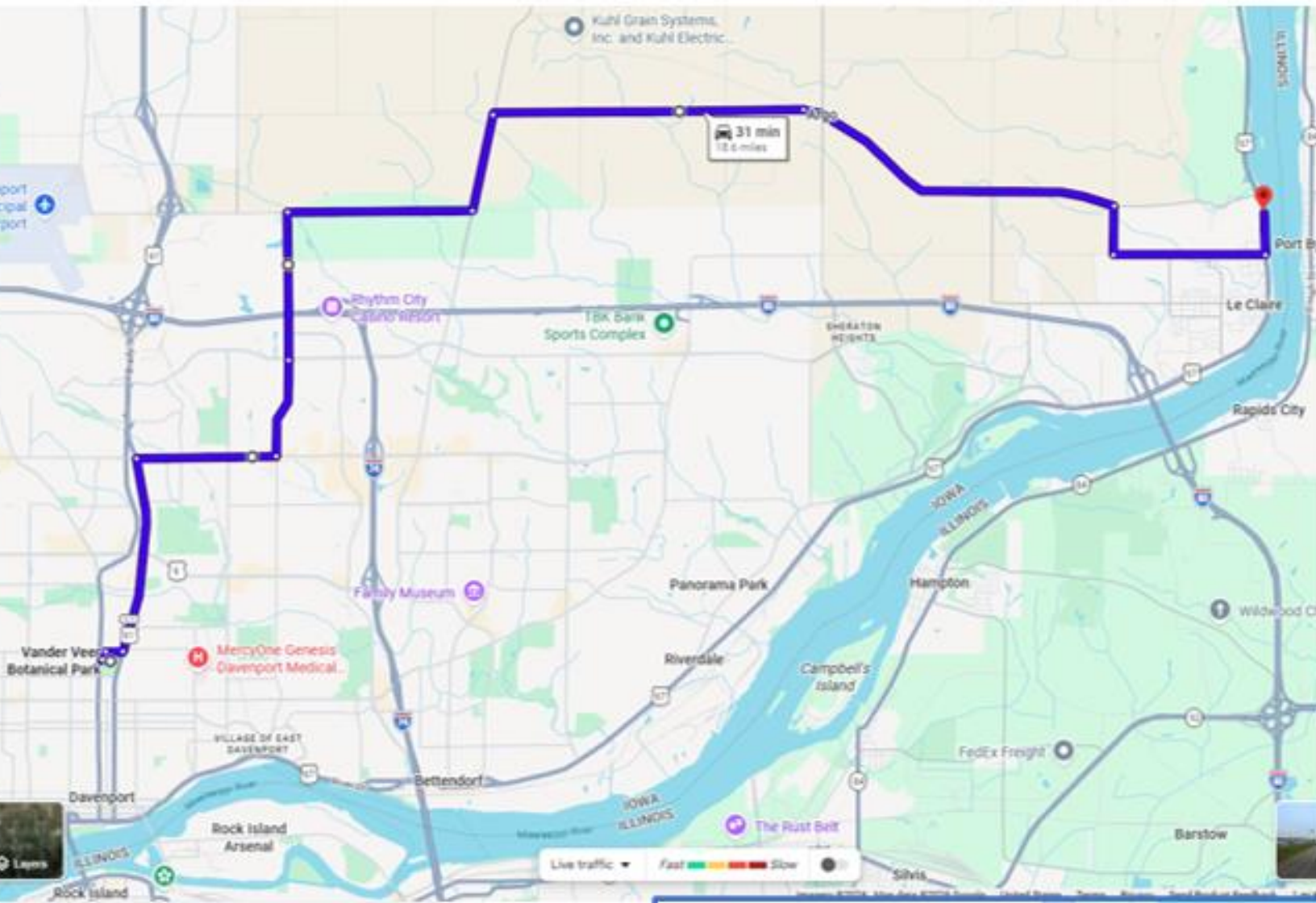
